



BLESSING YOUR CITY/REGION

"By the blessing of the upright the city is exalted" Prov. 11:11

1. We come in the Name that is above All names, Jesus Christ, whom we serve and Who has sent us to issue His Proclamation over you (Luke 4:18-19). We have come to bless and release peace (Luke 10:5), and as we have been commanded by our Lord and Savior we pray over you (Gen. 12:2-3).
2. Hear you: (Region/City), Ground, Trees, Air and Inhabitants of this Land, the Lord your God greatly desires your beauty (Psalm 45). We release upon you ears to hear and lips to call upon your God (Mark 7:31-37). No longer shall you be deserted; no more shall you be desolate. We hereby call forth the divine destiny to come alive and revive as your Creator determined for you before the foundation of the earth. We call forth the Life-Giving Wind of God to breath (Ez. 37) upon these streets and cause you to live. We will not be silent until your redemption comes; we will pray and stand with you as watchmen on a wall, making mention of you before the Lord day and night (Is. 62:6-7).
4. All of you, inhabitants of this land, hear the Voice of the Lord (John 10:27) calling you, receive right now ears to hear and eyes to see Jesus, your King. The Fear of the Lord shall rule your hearts and righteousness shall be established as your core foundation. Fear, oppression and evil shall flee from this land as justice, peace and truth are released to administer the affairs of men. We bless every street, every road, every highway and every corner of (Region/City) with wells of passions for the Beloved. We bless you with a ravishing yearning to know God and with an unquenchable thirst for His Presence. May a Supernatural Spirit of Conviction be birthed in the hearts of every person and a cry from their innermost being spring up to repent and turn to God.
6. We decree over (Region/City) that your Gates are wide open to the King of Glory. This region shall be a door and a gate through which the Glory Realm shall come in and spread out unto others. Your Visitation Time has come and we speak over you and awakening to seek the Lord, we release the resurrection power of Jesus Christ upon you. We declare life! We speak freedom upon you! We release the Blood of the Lamb over this land. We decree a hunger to know God over you. We release an insatiable desire to read the Bible and we call over you a mass move of hearts turning to God and crying out in repentance.
